I further agree to indemnify NERYC against any and all liability arising from any claim made by any person whose name appears below, including myself, arising from any damages or injuries sustained while in the NERYC Junior Sailing Summer Program or while on the premises of the NERYC or while using its facilities or equipment at any place. The consideration for the granting of this release and undertaking to indemnify NERYC is the undertaking of NERYC to permit those whose names appear below, including myself to enter upon the premises of the NERYC or while using its facilities or equipment at any place and or receive instruction in sailing. I also agree that the individuals I sign for will wear Coast Guard Approve Life Jackets at all times while on the docks or in the water.

Authorization and Consent

To ensure all participants have the opportunity to learn and enjoy their summer program experience, all campers agree to:

Respect and obey your instructors at all times

Be cooperative and participate with enthusiasm in all daily program activities

Treat others with respect

Be a good sport and ambassador for the club - be considerate in success, failure, victory or defeat.

Zero tolerance of bad language - profanity, obscene language, or obscene gestures will not be tolerated

Zero tolerance of physical violence, fighting or bullying tactics.

Zero tolerance of illegal substances: no supplying, possession or consumption of any drugs, alcohol, tobacco or any illegal substance whatsoever while at camp or on club premises

Refrain from wearing clothing displaying suggestive or improper words, pictures or designs

No horseplay on land or water at any time

No running on or jumping off the docks and of no throwing sand, stones, rocks etc.

Wear a life jacket AT ALL TIMES on, around or near the docks and the water

Remain within the set sailing water boundaries

Obtain the instructor permission to swim

Remain within the defined camp area on yacht club property at all times. PARENT/GAURDIANS MUST SIGN CAMPERS IN AND OUT EACH DAY

Treat the club boats and sailing equipment with care and respect - stow all boats neatly, return all equipment to its appropriate place in the shed each day and report any loss or damage to any equipment to your instructor

Treat the grounds and property of the club and marina with respect: keep the clubhouse, bathrooms and grounds clean and tidy by picking up your trash, keeping your personal equipment together in the assigned area, rinsing the sand off your feet and drying yourself before entering the buildings

All parents/guardians agree to:

Have campers arrive on time and ensure that they are picked up on time each day

Ensure their campers have and use adequate sun protection, wear appropriate clothing, bring a bathing suit, towel, lunch and a water bottle to camp each day

Respect the camp staff and allow the instructors to do their job without parental interference

I have read this document and understand that the camper may be asked to leave the Summer Camp Program if they disregard any of these rules or do not follow the code of conduct.
