

NERYC Transient - Policies and Procedures

Use of NERYC slips and moorings by visiting yachtsmen and/ or visiting fleets

1. NERYC welcomes visiting independent sailors and fleets to the North East River and encourages the use of NERYC slips and moorings subject to the following restrictions.
 - a. There will be no charge to visiting sailors who wish to tie to our slips and moorings to attend specific club events: races, opening day, card board dingy race during day light hours from 0600 to 1800 subject to availability.
 - b. Slips or spaces will be allocated by the dock master , dock master's designees or officer of the day in the following priority order and subject to wind and weather conditions: 1) Interior transient spaces; 2) Exterior transient spaces; 3) Un-leased slips; and 4) Vacant member slips.
 - c. Visitors will use their own dock lines and are requested not to use electricity.
2. Overnight visitors are also welcomed at NERYC. These will be either visits which are pre arranged i.e. reserved in advance or non reserved visitors. Reserved visitors will have priority over non reserved visitors for spaces.
3. Individuals or groups wishing to reserve a transient space can call or write to the club, or download the transient request form from the club website and send it to the dock master. A \$5.00 per vessel fee payable by credit card will be requested to save a space. This fee will be refundable up until 48 hours prior to the requested date
4. Overnight visitors will be assigned spaces by the dock master or officer of the day in the following priority order and subject to wind and weather conditions: 1) Interior transient slips A-1 and D-1; 2) Un-leased slips; 3) Vacant member slips and 3) Exterior transient slips A-2 and D-2 ; 4) Southern side of D dock. Boats may be rafted and each will be charged half the usual docking fee.
5. In the case of reserved groups, the dock master or designee will try and make advance slip assignments and provide to the officer of the day.
6. All overnight visitors will sign the agreement which absolves NERYC of liability, acknowledging that they dock at their own risk and provides the visitor with our rules for use of the docks and grounds.
7. Groups arriving will be signed in by the officer of the day as the guest of the officer of the day. The OOD will collect funds and provide a general orientation to the club as well as handing out a free drink pass to each captain.
8. Visitors who do not comply with the rules and regulations of the club and piers will be asked to leave by the OOD, dock master or member of the bridge.
