### BY ROAD

From I 95 S take exit 100A, from I 95 N take exit 100 on to R 272 S to North East. Alternately from R 40 /Pulaski Highway take R 272 S. Continue through the town of North East, travel 1 mile then bear right on to Hance Point Road, then travel half a mile and turn right on to Bayside Drive.

### BY WATER

From Turkey Point light, go North on the Northeast River. The club is to starboard of day marker 14.

Our new waterfront with concrete, floating piers will be completed in time for the boating season beginning in May 2007. This state of the art facility will have 77 modern slips, 9 moorings and the perimeter will provide additional transient dockage for up to 25 visiting boats.
